



7-Day Sri Lanka Heritage to Coastline Tour



From Ancient Cities to the Southern Seas

Day 01 – Arrival | Dambulla Cave Temple | Evening Safari Overnight: Habarana

Pickup at Bandaranaike International Airport (Katunayake):

Warm greetings by your guide upon arrival, followed by a scenic drive into Sri Lanka's Cultural Triangle.

• Visit to Dambulla Cave Temple:

Discover Sri Lanka's largest and best-preserved cave temple complex — the **Golden Rock Temple** of Dambulla. Marvel at the ancient murals and over 150 Buddha statues nestled in five sacred caves.

•Lunch in Dambulla:

Savor traditional Sri Lankan rice and curry in a peaceful garden setting.

Evening Safari (Minneriya/Kaudulla/Eco Park):

Embark on an unforgettable **jeep safari** in one of the seasonal elephants gathering parks. These lush reserves are home to elephants, deer, birds, and exotic wildlife in

their natural habitats.





Day 02 – Sacred Sites of Mihintale & Anuradhapura Overnight: Habarana

Mihintale – Cradle of Buddhism:

Climb the sacred rock of **Mihintale**, where Buddhism was first introduced to Sri Lanka in 247 BC. Explore the ancient stone steps, white dagobas, and panoramic views over the

surrounding plains.



• Anuradhapura Ancient City:

Explore the first capital of Sri Lanka and a UNESCO World Heritage Site. Visit majestic stupas (Ruwanwelisaya, Jetavanaramaya), the sacred Bodhi Tree (over 2,300 years old), and ancient monastic ruins. A deeply spiritual and historical journey through time.

Day 03 – Sigiriya to Kandy | Cultural Show & Sacred Temple Overnight: Kandy

Sigiriya Rock Fortress:

Climb the iconic **Sigiriya Lion Rock**, a 5th-century palace-fortress rising 200 meters above the jungle. Explore royal gardens, ancient frescoes, and panoramic summit views.







• Drive to Kandy:

Journey through lush greenery toward Sri Lanka's cultural capital.

• Evening in Kandy – Dance & Temple of the Tooth Relic:

Witness the famous **Kandyan cultural dance show**, then visit the **Temple of the Sacred Tooth Relic (Sri Dalada Maligawa)**, a spiritual heart of Buddhism in Sri Lanka.



Day 04 - Kandy | Botanical Garden | Highlands & Tea

Overnight: Nuwara Eliya

• Kandy City Tour:

Visit the Kandy viewpoint, local handicraft centers, and stroll along the serene **Kandy Lake**.

Peradeniya Botanical Gardens:

Wander through one of Asia's finest botanical gardens, home to exotic orchids, royal palms, and a massive canopy of tropical trees.

•Scenic Drive via Ramboda Falls: Stop at Ramboda Falls and enjoy a picturesque lunch overlooking tea plantations and misty mountains.

•Tea Factory & Plantation Tour:

Learn the art of making Ceylon tea at a working factory. Walk through emerald-green plantations and taste freshly brewed tea at its origin.

Day 05 – Hill Country to Ella by Train | Nature Walks

Overnight: Ella

•Nuwara Eliya City Tour:

Visit **Gregory Lake**, colonial-era buildings, and local markets in this charming "Little England" town.



Train Ride from Nanu Oya to Ella:

Experience Sri Lanka's most scenic rail journey — glide past valleys, tea fields, waterfalls, and mountain passes. A photographer's dream!

Pick-up at Ella Station:

Your driver will meet you at Ella station.



Nine Arches Bridge & Little Adam's Peak:

Visit the Nine Arches Bridge, an architectural marvel surrounded by dense jungle.

Then hike to Little Adam's Peak for breathtaking sunset views over the valley.


Day 06 – Waterfalls, Rock Carvings & Southern Escape Overnight: Mirissa

•Rawana Waterfall:

Stop at the beautiful **Rawana Falls**, cascading down from the highlands into the southern jungles.







Buduruwagala Rock Statues:

Visit this hidden gem — a peaceful archaeological site featuring massive rock-carved Buddha statues dating back to the 10th century, set in a tranquil forested setting.

Drive to Mirissa:

Arrive in the tropical beach town of **Mirissa**, known for its palm-fringed shores and whale watching.



Day 07 – Whale Watching | Galle Fort | Departure End in Colombo / Airport Drop-off

Whale Watching (Seasonal Activity):

Early morning boat ride from **Mirissa Harbor** to spot **blue whales, sperm whales**, and dolphins (best from November to April).

Visit Galle Fort:

Explore the **UNESCO-listed Galle Dutch Fort**, a 17th-century seaside fortress with colonial buildings, art galleries, cafes, and lighthouse views.

Scenic Drive Along the Coast:

Travel along the southern shoreline with glimpses of stilt fishermen and golden beaches.

• Evening Drop-Off at Colombo or Bandaranaike International Airport (Katunayake):

Transfer back to the airport or your hotel in Colombo with beautiful memories of your Sri

Lankan adventure.
